

## CHUNKY CROCHET THROW PATTERN



### WHAT YOU WILL NEED

Here is what you will need to make this throw:

- A size K (6.5 mm) Crochet Hook
- Bulky weight yarn in two colours. I used 9 skeins each of Loops & Threads Woollike Chunky (125 g or 4.4 Oz per skein) in Rose and Beige
- Scissors

### MEASUREMENTS

46" Wide X 52" Long

## PATTERN

This pattern uses the Dutchess Lace Stitch. You can find a tutorial for this stitch at: [newstitchaday.com](http://newstitchaday.com)

With Colour A, Chain 112.

Row 1: [2 DC, 3 CH, 1 Slip Stitch] in 4th ch from hook, \*skip next 2 ch, [2 DC, 3 CH, 1 Slip Stitch] in next ch; repeat from \* to end of row, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, \*[2 DC, 3 CH, 1 Slip Stitch] in next ch3 space; repeat from \* across, ending in 1 DC in top of turning chain, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, \*working in each chain of the ch3 of previous row, 1 DC in first ch, 1 DC in 2nd ch, CH 3, 1 Slip Stitch in 3rd ch; repeat from \* across, ending with 1 DC in top of the turning ch, turn.

Switch to Colour B at the end of row 3.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 three times and then switch back to colour A.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 three times and then switch back to colour B.

Continue this pattern until your work measures over 4 feet (or as long as you desire). Finish the pattern by working the last three rows in colour A to mirror the first three rows. Fasten off and weave in all loose ends.
